#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

#### 1. In Jesus' story, who is the Good Shepherd?

 Jesus is the Good Shepherd, and He laid down His life for all of us by dying on the cross.

# 2. Who are the sheep?

 The sheep represent us. We get lost from God very easily, which is why we rejoice knowing that He never stops looking for us!

# 3. What does the hired man do when he sees the sheep are in danger?

• He runs away because he does not own, nor cares for the sheep.

# 4. How does Jesus protect us?

 He knows us by name. He leads us out. He goes ahead of us. We know His voice. He lays down His life for us.

# 5. Who or what is leading you away from God?

 Some examples could be having bad relationships, being greedy with money, watching too much TV, and being mean to housemates/staff/people at work.

# 6. Why is it easier to follow the wrong people or things, instead of God?

 Some examples could be it's more fun, being pressured by others, and being lazy.

#### 7. How can we stay close to God (the Good Shepherd)?

• Being in Christian community, going to church, attending your weekly Friendship group, having devotions at home, and praying.

#### 8. What does Jesus promise to do for the sheep?

 Jesus promised to lay down His life for the sheep, which He did by dying on the cross.

#### 1. What did Jesus do for the world?

 God loves us so much that He sent Jesus to die, to save us from sin. If we believe in Jesus, we will have eternal life with God!
