Connection Ministries is founded on the beliefs:

- There is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (*Matthew 28:19; John 10:30; Ephesians 4:4-6*).
- In the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His substitutionary and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory (*Matthew 1:23; John 1:1-4; Acts 1:11 and 2:22-24; Romans 8:34;1 Corinthians 15:3-4; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Philippians 2:5-11; Hebrews 1:1-4 and 4:15*).
- The Bible is the inspired, infallible, only authoritative Word of God for all matters of faith, practice and life, revealing God's love to the world (1 Thessalonians 2:13; 2 Timothy 3:15-17; John 3:16).
- All people are created in God's image, including people with disabilities (*Genesis 1:27*).
- All people everywhere are lost and face the judgment of God, that Jesus Christ is the only way of salvation, and that for the salvation of lost and sinful mankind, repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ results in regeneration by the Holy Spirit (*Luke 24:46-47; John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Romans 3:23; 2 Corinthians 5:10-11; Ephesians 1:7 and 2:8-9; Titus 3:4-7*).
- In the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, and that we all will face the judgment of God. Jesus Christ is the only way of salvation, and God will reward those in Christ with eternal life in heaven (*John 5:28-29; 1 Corinthians 15:51-57; Revelation 20:11-15*).
- In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, who enables the Christian to live a godly life (John 3:5-8; Acts 1:8 and 4:31; Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 2:14; Galatians 5:16-18; Ephesians 6:12; Colossians 2:6-10).
- The Holy Spirit gives spiritual gifts to all believers, including people with disabilities, according to the grace given to them (*1 Corinthians 12:7; Romans 12:6-8*).
- In the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ which includes believers with disabilities (*1 Corinthians 12:12, 27; Ephesians 1:22-23*).
